E2BN held its annual conference on the 5th and 6th July 2005. This exciting event attracted over 200 delegates and pupils from Crosshall Junior School and St Mary's CofE Primary School added an extra dimension to proceedings with their enthusiastic use of Making the News.

The money will be used to give many children the same educational opportunities we enjoy in the UK, giving them a hope for the future.
